

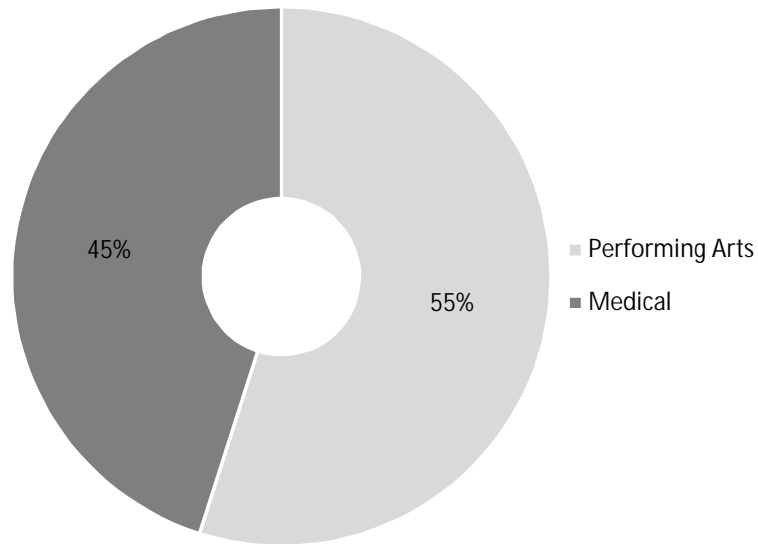

2019 Outcomes of Grant Applications across key focus areas:  
Performing Arts, Medical Services and Research in Victoria

# Summary of Grant Applications

In FY19, the Foundation received a **total of 51 grant applications** across the two key funding areas of focus being Performing Arts, Medical Service and Research as summarised below:



Funding Focus Area	Number of Applicants	Amount Requested
Performing Arts	28	\$653,687
Medical	23	\$553,401

# Outcome of Grant Applicants

The Foundation wishes to commend all grant applicants on the important work they do and the positive impact this contributes to Victoria and its communities.

With a limited capacity of funds available for distribution for the FY 2019, the Foundation has decided to distribute:

- **10** grant applicants are to receive funding within the **Performing Arts** space, with 1 grant applicant receiving the full funding amount requested
- **6** grant applicants are to receive funding within the **Medical Services and Research** focus area, with 3 grant applicants receiving the full funding amount requested
- **3** of the grant applicants have **not previously received funding** from the Foundation

All applicants were advised of the outcome of their applications on Friday, 7 June 2019 with funding distributed before 30 June 2019.

# Decision making process

The following themes and considerations influenced the Advisory Committee when considering the FY19 portfolio of funding partners:

## **Medical Research grants:**

- Emphasis on organisations and projects that support conditions of the eye
- Equal representation between funding medical capital/infrastructure projects and research initiatives funded

## **Performing Arts**

- A preference for funding artistic fees over production or capital costs associated with performing arts projects
